RockFish Youth Services (RYS) is a ministry of RockFish Church encompassing youth in every stage of life.

At Risk Youth and Vocational Training

RYS at risk youth and vocational training program focuses on Hoke County youth, 6 to 21 years old, who need intervention or vocational development. While we can accept referrals from almost anywhere, all youth must complete an application process.

RYS conducts an assessment of each youth through proven inventories like the Youth Level of Service/Case Management Inventory to develop a biblically-based, individual plan to guide each youth successfully through the program and beyond. In addition to presentations of Gospel truths, each youth will be challenged to consider associations with peers and given skills to correct behavioral problems.

In addition, RYS offers the VALPAR Career Exploration and Assessment along with work adjustment training and vocational Evaluation services. We aim to help your youth gain valuable vocational skills.



RYS offers discussions and training using the Bible as our guide. Clients can develop life changing abilities through Christian mentoring and the power of obedience to the Gospel as they learn interpersonal skills and vocational training.

Youth Activities

Weekly Bible studies, drama and puppet teams, and weekend trips are just a few of the exciting adventures awaiting your 6th-12th Grader.

Alien Youth Group

Alien Youth Group is a safe place for youth 12 to 18 years old to grow in faith and be challenged to fulfill God's plans for their lives. Regular meetings are every Wednesday at 7:30p.m. Additional events and ministry opportunities are planned throughout the year to enhance the weekly meetings and challenge the youth.

Crystal Dreams

Available for teens age 12 and up, Crystal Dreams ministers through drama and puppetry. Weekly practices include devotions to unite the team under the cross of Christ as they minister to others through their presentations.
