Children's Church Activities

Children's Church activities and lessons are prepared using Group Publishing's "Hands on Bible" curriculum.

Weekly Bible study lessons and activities teach our children how to use the Bible and apply the word of God to their daily lives.

In addition to our weekly studies, the children at RockFish Church occasionally enjoy popcorn and a movie, puppet skits, and dramas to reinforce Bible lessons.

Children's Church Policies

Health Policy:

In order to maintain a safe, healthy environment for our children and to prevent the spread of illness, we request that you not send your child to children's programs if he has shown any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours: fever, rash, vomiting, diarrhea, runny nose, persistent cough, or pink-eye.

Discipline Policy:

Positive behavior is expected at all times in children's church programs. Any inappropriate behavior will be discussed with the Children's Church coordinator. If unacceptable behavior continues, the parent will be asked to remove the child from the classroom for the remainder of the service.

Programs offered:

Sunday Programs:

Children's Church
for ages 2 - 6th grade

Children ages 2 years through 6th grade are released after praise and worship to go to their classrooms. Please pick up your children from their classrooms immediately after service.

11:00 Childcare

Childcare is provided for children of parents attending classes during this time. Children ages 6 weeks through 24 months may check-in at the nursery. Children ages 2 through 6th grade may be check-in at classroom number 4.

Wednesday Programs:

- Nursery is provided for ages 6 weeks thru 36 months in the nursery area.
- Childcare for ages 4 - 1st grade takes place in classroom number 4.
- Bible study for children in 2nd-5th grade takes place in classroom number 3.

Check-in and Check-out

Check-in procedure:

Parents are encouraged to arrive 10-15 minutes before service to allow for adequate check-in time. At the check-in table in the foyer, parents sign-in each child on the appropriate clip board. Each child receives a randomly numbered security sticker that also serves as a name tag. The parent keeps the corresponding number stub.

Check-out procedure:

Immediately after service is over, parents present the corresponding number stub at the classroom to receive their child. Please be prompt in this matter to avoid delays in preparing for the next class.
