Nursery Policies

Health Policy:

In order to maintain a safe, healthy environment for our children and to prevent the spread of illness, we request that you not send your child to the nursery if he/she has shown any of the following symptoms in the past 24 hours: fever, rash, vomiting, diarrhea, runny nose, persistent cough, pink-eye, rash, or open sores.

Discipline Policy:

Positive behavior will be encouraged. Gentle correction will be used for offenses such as hitting, biting, taking toys, etc. If an older baby continues to misbehave after gentle correction, a parent will be called to remove the child from the nursery for the remainder of the service. Under no circumstances will a caregiver apply corporal punishment.

Registration:

Check-in procedure:

Parents are encouraged to arrive 10-15 minutes before service to allow for adequate check-in time. At the nursery check-in counter, parents will fill out a form to register their child. The nursery worker will then give the child and the parent a security sticker. The number on the security stub will appear on the bottom of the screen in the worship center if the parent is needed during the service.

Check-out procedure:

Immediately after service is over, parents present the corresponding number stub at the nursery to pick-up their child. Please be prompt in this matter to avoid delays in preparing for the next service.

Snacks:

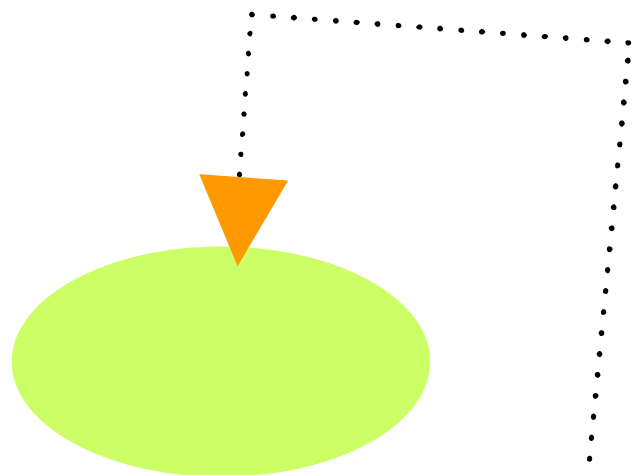
Older babies often receive a snack of animal crackers or cheerios cereal. Please be sure to write in any food allergies on your child's nametag label.
